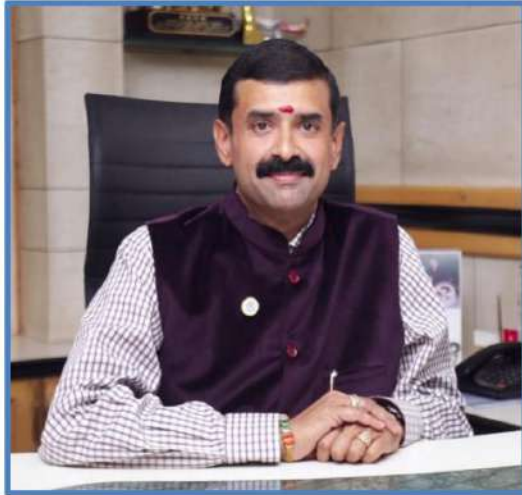

Preamble:

Nehru College of Nursing promoted by Nehru Educational and Charitable Trust is situated at panayur road, vaniyamkulam, Ottapalam Palakkad to cater to this felt and assured need for a quality Nursing Institution at reach. The College of Nursing has left an indelible mark on bringing up Curricular, Co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. These ventures help the students to evolve into truly global nursing professional standard and attire of dynamicity as gratified citizens.

Introduction

This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the B.Sc. Nursing Course, against sanctioned intake for the academic year 2021-22, in the college, including 15% NRI seats set apart for the dependents of Non Resident Indians.

This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of Honorable Courts of law/ Approving Authority

Number of seats and details of reservation

The College has been conducting B.Sc. Nursing Course with an intake of 60 seats. Now, it has obtained approval from the Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council for the total intake of 90 seats and awaiting for the approval from Indian Nursing Council and Kerala University of Health Sciences. As usual, the College is willing for the seat sharing with the Hon'ble Govt. of Kerala i. e. 45 seats for Merit and Management Quotas respectively. Out of the above 90 seats, 15% seats will be filled up by the candidates from NRI quota 35% of the seats shall be filled up under the Management Quota. The remaining 50% seats are allotted by LBS under merit quota as per the consensual agreement with the Govt. of Kerala. The details of reservation of seats are as follows.

- In the event of non availability of eligible candidates in the NRI quota, such seats will be filled up by the candidates in the management quota. If sufficient candidates are not available in the general merit such seats will be filled up by the candidates from management quota.
- The number of seats, allocation of seats under various quota may also change subject to conditions to any consensual agreement that may be signed between Government of Kerala and the college.
- *(If the total number of seats under NRI quota is an odd number, equal representation will be accomplished in a period of two years)

Eligibility for Admission

Academic:

- **Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with Aggregate of minimum 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 45% marks in English in second year and who secured 50% marks in the entrance examination.**
- **Admission of candidate will be subject to the rules & regulations of the competent authorities from time to time.**

Relaxation in marks:

- **Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with total annual family income up to Rs.6.00 lakhs will have relaxation of 5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Candidates in the State of Kerala need 40% marks in the qualifying examination.**
- **Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management quota.**
- **Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.**

Age:

- **Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2022. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.**
- **Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/certificate showing the date of birth/copy of birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission**

How to Apply.

- Application for admission to course B.Sc.Nursing course can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website <http://nehrunursing.com/> . Prospectus can also be downloaded from the website. However, it will not be available by post. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the candidature.

Application Fee:

- The application fee will be Rs.1000/-for all candidates, payable through Online / Offline by using Credit/Debit/Internet Banking facility.
- Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of Application fee through online/offline.
- If the payment is debited and you are not guided to the second stage please inform us to info.nehru@gmail.com with your log in details or email-id or mobile number, we will provide you the required help within 24Hrs.
- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.

Remittance of Application Fee and Submission of Application Form:

- The candidates can get the instruction to make the payment and submission of application form in the link “Admission” on the website <http://nehrunursing.com/>.
- No need of submission of hardcopy of application

Preparation of Merit List (Management quota &NRI Quota)

Meritlist:

- Out of 45seats 32 seats will be filled by management from among the online applications on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria by following the reservation criteria as mention in this prospectus.
- Out of 45 seats 13 NRI seats shall be filled up from qualified students as per G.O (MS)No.243/2014/HRFWDdated6.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala.
- The following original documents shall be submitted at the time of admission.
 - Sponsorship Certificate
 - Attested copy of the passport of the sponsor
 - The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.
 - Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar*

(*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order No. GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/KUHS/2014 , dated 12.06.2014)

Resolution of tie while ranking :

- In the case of a tie in the total marks, the marks in Biology will count. If there is still a tie the marks in Chemistry and Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder will be preferred to the younger.

Validity of the merit list:

- The published merit list will be valid till 31-12-2022 or the date up to which the merit list shall be kept alive in terms of instruction/direction of competent authority.
- Inclusion in the merit list will not entitle the applicant eligible for admission to the course, unless the applicant satisfy the rules regarding the eligibility for admission and other conditions as laid down in the Prospectus.
- Furnishing of false information/ particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.



Selection by Allotment Process

- The Allotment Process for Seats in Nehru College of Nursing for which will be made as per the schedule included in the prospectus and allotments will be strictly based on the merit by following the reservation criteria as mention in this prospectus.
- If sufficient candidates are not available in the list of applicants, the vacant seats will be filled up from the eligible candidates from the spot allotment.

Admission & Payment of Fees

- The selected candidates will be informed through call / SMS in to the registered mobile number provided in the application.
- The students shall pay all fees of the 1st year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded at any circumstances.
- The entire candidate should pay Miscellaneous fee & Other fees due to statutory bodies (KUHS, KNMC & INC) as and when notified later by the College /Government .
- Selected Candidates should report for admission on the date as instructed in the call / SMS along with the following documents
 - Aadhar card or any other identity proof as provided in the application.
 - Mark list of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
 - Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
 - Document (School Record, SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
 - Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
 - A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.
 - Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
 - Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last attended.
 - Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application for reservation.

The candidates selected for NRI quota have to submit the following documents also along with the above documents

- Sponsorship Certificate
- Attested copy of the passport of the sponsor
- The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.
- Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar*

(*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order No. GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/KUHS/2014 , dated 12.06.2014)

- Selected candidates have to remit all the fees as mentioned above at the time of admission itself. The fee can be paid by RTGS/NEFT/DD/Net banking/Online banking. If all the fee as mentioned above is not remitted within the time of admission, the application of the Candidate will be removed from the admission process.
- If any candidate discontinues the course ,after closing of admission as notified by the authority,the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course(4yrs). The Collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the AFRC or Court of Law.

Special Instructions

Ragging:

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in college. college are committed to abolish ragging in their campuses. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard.

Use of Mobile Phone:

Use of Mobile Phone by students are not allowed in the campuses and hostels without permission from college authorities. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.

Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the Controller of admission.
